

# New Teambuilding Events

## Our Team Cooks

The team plans, prepares, sets up, cooks, serves (and eats!!!) a formal luncheon under the direction of the BRC Trainer and the Green Island Country Club Banquet Staff. Special “opportunities” will arise for the group to solve during the event and a debriefing will take place at the end to facilitate the Team Learning process. Fun and Challenging. Pick the meal, make the arrangements, cook/prepare the meal, solve problems and do it all as a team.



## The Perfect Score

Team plays a combined 18/27 holes of golf at Green Island Country Club using the Scramble scenario, attempting to score a combined score of Par or better with parts of the team playing different parts of the course and overcoming obstacles. Walkie talkies will be provided for communications to allow for collaboration, group decision making, problem solving, etc. A group debriefing will take place at the end where learning is connected to everyday work life.

## “Reel” Team Building

Team will attempt to catch a combined total of fish that add up to a perfect score of 100. The team will be divided onto groups around three different lakes. The object will be to collect points by catching different species and sizes of fish to achieve a perfect 100 score. The lakes are stocked with bass, bream, pickerel, catfish and some surprises. The team must communicate via walkie talkies to make sure that they solve problems that arise, do not go over the required points limit, catch the right combination of fish and avoid penalties that might be imposed by the umpire. (No boats allowed) A group debriefing will take place at the end where team members share what they learned and the facilitator offers observations.



## The Amazing Leadership Race

Large groups compete as teams in our version of reality television’s Amazing Race. Traveling from “country to country”, each team will be faced with tasks to accomplish and obstacles to overcome. These include such activities as catching fish, hitting golf balls, mind challenging activities, finding their way through corporate minefields, scaling the tower of success and stepping outside one’s comfort zone on hundreds of acres of beautiful farmland, all the while getting practice in budgeting time and money and experiencing situational leadership. At the debriefing, teams explore the many lessons learned that are applicable in their workplace.
