What is Basic Training for Couples?

Basic Training for Couples was created to strengthen African-American marriages. This program educates dating, engaged or married couples about the value of commitment, responsibility, psychological differences between the sexes, sexual intimacy and conflict resolution. Couples will also learn about the history of the African-American marriage and many, for the first time, plot their own family tree to trace marriages and divorces.

Who are the Facilitators?

Basic Training for Couples is the brain child of **Dr. Rozario Slack** and **Nisa Muhammad**. Both spent a considerable amount of time working with Black people across the country who asked for marriage education materials that were relevant to their experience. Dr. Slack, is a much sought-after speaker who travels across the country to conduct seminars in the areas of marriage, fathering and other issues that profoundly impact children and families.
